YWCA South Hampton Roads

- Located in Norfolk in the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Congressional Districts of Virginia.
- Provides Sexual Assault and Trafficking; Domestic Violence and Safety; Children's and Family Development; and Economic Advancement services to 8,913 women, 3,229 girls, and 1,895 boys and men each year.
- 49% of the people we serve are low income, and 50% are people of color.
- We have 107 employees, 86 volunteers, and generate \$2,369,503 in gross revenue to serve our community.
- Across our state, there are 4 YWCAs reaching 45,182 women, girls and family members.

Federal Funding Makes a Difference in Our Community

- We rely on \$833,339 in VOCA funding and \$182,624 in HUD funding to provide services in our community.
- With these federal funds, we have been able to provide wraparound services to more than 8,000 victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, human trafficking and stalking in the South Hampton Roads area last year alone.
- We also rely on local, state, and private funding from state agencies, and state coalitions.
